

Largo Public Library Types of Library Cards

Free Cooperative Card

Identified as a blue plastic card or matching key card. This card is issued to patrons living within the City of Largo, the unincorporated areas of Pinellas County, within those areas participating in the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative, Inc., and residents of areas not in the Cooperative owning a residence, property, or business within the Cooperative area and showing proof of the same, such as:

- a current TRIM notice or tax bill,
- a current utility bill (electric, water, cable),
- a printed long-term lease on property within the Cooperative area,
- a deed to property in the Cooperative area,
- a vehicle / mobile home registration or title (for the current year),
- a homestead exemption form,
- a voter's registration card, or
- a circulation address verification post card.

Patrons who reside locally part-time, but who can prove ownership (a tax bill or deed) will be issued the Free Cooperative Card. The Free Cooperative Card is valid for three years.

Cooperative library cards are issued to owners of businesses located within the participating areas. Occupational licenses may be used as identification for each business. The individual in whose name the occupational license is issued is eligible for a Cooperative library card, but it may be used by family members. However, only one individual per business will be issued a library card.

Fee Cooperative Card

Identified as a white plastic card or matching key card. The Fee Cooperative Card is issued to patrons not living within the area covered by the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative, Inc. The Fee Cooperative Card is issued to patrons living in Belleair, Belleair Beach, Belleair Bluffs, Indian Rocks Beach, Indian Shores, Kenneth City, and South Pasadena. The annual fee per household is \$100. A family purchasing a \$100 nonresident card will be issued a library card, and all members of the family are eligible to receive his or her own card.

Restricted Card for Visitors

Identified as a white plastic card or matching key card. The Restricted Card for Visitors is issued to patrons who reside up to six (6) months within the area served by the Cooperative, who cannot provide current proof of local residence. The fee for the Restricted Card for Visitors is \$25 for three months or less, and \$50 for up to six months of borrowing privileges at Largo Public Library and all other libraries belonging to the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative, Inc.

Free Card for City of Largo Employees

City of Largo employees and members of the employee's family residing in the same home, but living outside the Cooperative area, are eligible for a free cooperative card. The cards will be returned to the City upon separation from employment.

Computer Use Only Cards

Computer Use Only Cards are issued to patrons who may not qualify for a library card or who only intend to use the public access computers. The card is issued to:

- adults (18 years of age and older) with photo identification (driver license, school identification, work identification, or credit card with photograph); adult computer use only cards are valid only on the public access computers in the adult areas of the library;
- young adults (ages 13 - 17); photo identification must be provided (same as adult). The young adult computer cards are valid on the public access computers in the Teen Room and in some of the adult areas of the library;
- children (ages 0 - 12); the children computer cards are valid only on the public access computers in the children's room; children are not required to present picture identification unless staff is unable to determine the child's correct name or date of birth.

Computer Use Only Cards may not be transferred from one individual to another. All card holders involved will have their computer use privileges revoked. The Computer Use Only Card is valid for one (1) year.

Computer Use Pass

Used for one hour per day as a temporary option for people who do not qualify for a Free Cooperative Card.
