### DEPARTMENT SPONSORED EVENTS

During the month of November, Largo Fire participated in 16 public events that reached approximately 1,350 people in the areas of fire safety programs, home safety preparedness programs and fall prevention. Twenty-two smoke detectors were installed.

### BUDGET UPDATE

For the month of November, Fire has experienced a total of 2229.50 hours of overtime. Minimum staffing accounted for 44.9% or 1001.75 hours of the overtime at a cost of \$35,525.07. Special events, department committees, and training account for the remainder of the overtime assignments.
