**PRESENTATION OF FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES' HOME RULE RALLY TROPHY FOR BEST USE OF THEME TO THE MEMBER GOVERNMENTS OF THE SUNCOAST LEAGUE OF CITIES; PRESENTATION OF FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES' THE HISTORY OF HOME RULE VIDEO**

A Home Rule Rally was held on August 17, 2018 at the 92<sup>nd</sup> Annual Conference of the Florida League of Cities (FLC). The theme of this year's annual conference was the Fiftieth Anniversary of Home Rule. Following the Home Rule Rally, the FLC presented the Suncoast League of Cities with a trophy for Best Use of Theme. As the First Vice President of the Suncoast League of Cities, Commissioner John Carroll will present the trophy to the City Commission on behalf of the Suncoast League of Cities. The trophy will travel around to member governments of the Suncoast League of Cities and be presented to the respective City Commissions/City Councils/Town Commissions.

Additionally, the FLC produced a video, entitled *The History of Home Rule*, which will be previewed by the City Commission and broadcast to the viewers at home so that citizens can learn the history of Municipal Home Rule and become informed about the concept of and principles associated with local self governance.

The Suncoast League of Cities consists of 25 member cities in 3 counties and represents over one million citizens. The member governments range, geographically, from St. Leo in the North to Gulfport in the South. The Suncoast League works closely with and is supported by the FLC in representing the interests of West Central Florida's municipalities to the Florida Legislature, the Governor's office and state agencies. The Suncoast League also provides a foundation for developing and assisting the FLC on urban policy and municipal administration issues on a statewide basis.
